Thanks for your interest in applying for funding from the ONE Good Deed Fund. We're looking forward to reading about your idea for a good deed for your neighborhood! Please note before you start that projects must take place in Burlington, VT's Old North End neighborhood, that only individuals can apply (nonprofits and other organizations are not eligible for funding), that all projects must be completed within a year of notification of funding, and that funding will not be issued directly to the applicant – it will be issued to the vendor(s) who are selling the items or services needed to complete the project.

What we fund:

- Neighborhood projects spearheaded by individuals and groups in the Old North End
- Neighborhood celebrations and events that bring Old North End residents together

What we do not fund:

- Projects outside of the Old North End
- Projects run by nonprofits and businesses (exceptions may be made for very small groups - please contact us)
- Events that do not primarily benefit ONE residents
- Events for which there are multiple sponsors
